Short-Instruction:

The way begins with a clear revelation from God. We recognize where we have become a victim and where we have been the offender. This legitimates us to accuse the involved persons before God.

Every sin is firstly directed against God and then against yourself and your neighbour **(1)**.

After the accusation the way leads to the cross, where Jesus died. We crucified Jesus with our sin(s). We take full responsibility, as we admit being guilty. We also confess the consequences of our sin! This leads us into deep repentance before God and later on before the involved persons **(2)**.

Next the way leads into real forgiveness. In the blood of Jesus Christ we have forgiveness of our sin(s). We step out of every victim status and willfully take the forgiveness. Then we forgive everyone, who sinned against us. The offender is now free and authorized to ask the victims for forgiveness. We experience inner healing from our hurts. We drive out demons and experience physical healing **(3)**.

From forgiveness the process leads to reconciliation. We are being reconciled to God, to our biography and to our neighbour! If our counterpart does not agree, we can still go on **(4)**.

After reconciliation the way leads us to redemption. Old patterns of living are left behind and new ones are practiced. The supernatural life through the Holy Spirit can now be experienced **(5)**.

Now the way leads to rehabilitation/restoration. This regards the personal calling as well as the missed appreciation and honor. The way always leads to the house of the father **(6)**.

We stand before God with new awe, fear of God and deeper love **(7)** and we worship him. New revelation leads us afresh into the open circuit.
